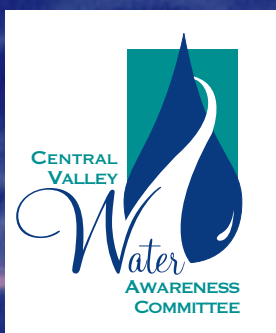

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Introduction

No resource is more vital to life than water. Delivering this vital resource to customers in the Central San Joaquin Valley is the job of a surprisingly large number of private companies and public agencies. Some are large and complex. Others are tiny and modest.

These providers serve different types of users. There are irrigation and water districts that join stockholder-owned canal companies in delivering supplies of surface water that are vital to the region's massive agricultural industry. And then there are cities, and other districts and private firms that deliver the water used in homes, businesses and industries.

Although their deliveries differ, each agency efficiently provides safe and reliable supplies of water for beneficial use by their customers while encouraging sound conservation practices and wise water use.

The Central Valley Water Awareness Committee, as part of its many activities highlighting California's annual observance of Water Awareness Month in May, is pleased to present this all new *Central San Joaquin Valley Water Agency Directory*.

Like the Committee's original volume several years ago, this Directory lists addresses, telephone numbers and other important information about many of Central San Joaquin Valley's numerous water providers, as well as other water-related districts and organizations. We hope it will be a useful tool, not only for becoming acquainted with the region's water providers but in getting to better know the Valley's outstanding water professionals.

The Central Valley Water Awareness Committee

It's easy to take water for granted. Thanks to highly efficient and economical delivery systems, reliable supplies of safe, clean water in homes, businesses and industries are only a turn of the faucet or an opening of a valve away. On farms, water is delivered for irrigation by flowing through the countryside in canal systems that have been part of the valley landscape since the 1870s and 1880s.

The Central Valley Water Awareness Committee's members are all professionals in various segments of Central San Joaquin Valley's water industry. They are dedicated to helping improve appreciation of the importance of water, where it comes from and how it is beneficially used to make possible our valley's way of life. The Committee also strives to enhance understanding of often-complex water issues that continue to confront our region.

California's first statewide Water Awareness Committee was established in 1987 by the Association of California Water Agencies, the California Department of Water Resources and the Water Education Foundation. Its role was to sponsor events and activities that educate the public and raise awareness of how high-quality water is

efficiently delivered to homes and farms. Local agencies were encouraged to develop their own water awareness programs.

Under the leadership of the Fresno Irrigation District, our region's many water agencies and organizations created what soon became known as the Central Valley Water Awareness Committee.

The Committee's role today is as it was in the beginning. It produces an annual campaign to commemorate Water Awareness Month each May along with other events and activities throughout the year. The Committee has emphasized water education projects, particularly those that concentrate on water related issues and needs — both rural and urban — within Fresno County and the Central San Joaquin Valley.

Water Sources of the Central San Joaquin

The Central San Joaquin Valley has a variety of water sources, all of which in some way are affected by the hydrologic cycle illustrated on the next page.

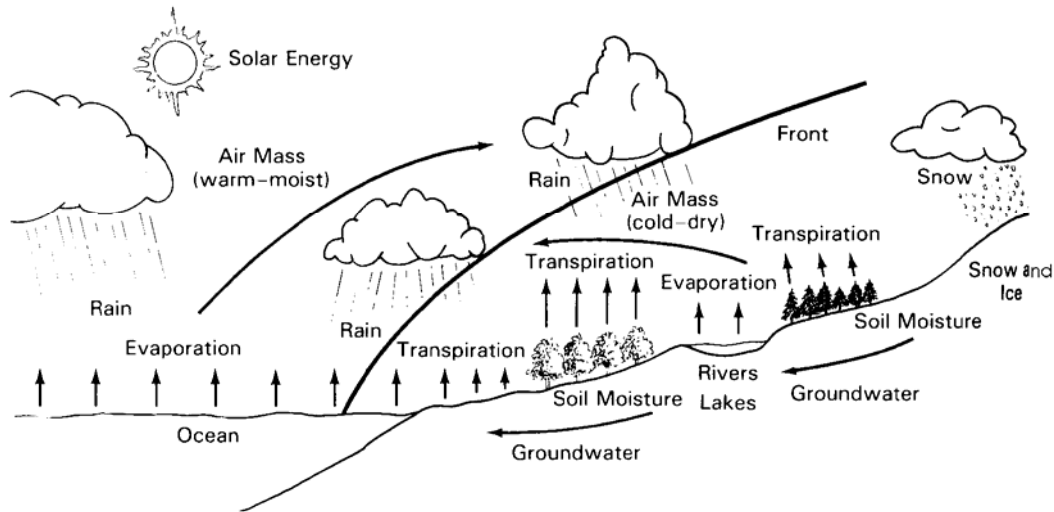
Water is dynamic. It is always on the move, by sea, by air, by land and underground. In the process, water provides life for all of us.

With its typically hot and dry summers, the Valley may seem well removed from the ocean but the Pacific is the source of storm events that spread rain over the Valley and its foothills while draping blankets of snow across the high Sierra Nevada.

Sierra snow is perhaps the best known and most dramatic source of the Valley's water supply. Central California's "wet season" begins during the fall and snow accumulates at higher elevations through April. Warming weather unleashes the

snowmelt season, swelling flows in rivers reaching into the Valley from the mountains.

Snowmelt runoff as well as even bigger (but shorter duration) flood flows that are spawned occasionally by heavy rains are captured behind Pine Flat Dam, managed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, on the Kings River and Friant Dam, operated by the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, on the San Joaquin River. In Pine Flat Reservoir and Millerton Lake, these big flows are tamed, managed and stored for flood control as well as for spring and summer irrigation use by tens of thousands of valley farmers.

A vast network of canals radiates from the Kings River, providing deliveries to the 28 local agencies with vested water rights and entitlements. The Kings River service area includes nearly 20,000 farms and over one million acres in portions of Fresno, Kings and Tulare counties.

At the Central Valley Project's (CVP) Friant Dam, San Joaquin River water is diverted into the Friant-Kern and Madera canals. There are 28 districts and cities (the largest of which is Fresno) with water service contracts from the CVP in parts of Merced, Madera, Fresno, Tulare and Kern counties. The Friant service area includes nearly one million acres and 15,000 farms.

On the Valley's West Side, there are two canals that are tremendously important water sources. Both provide water delivered to the Valley from the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta and north state reservoirs.

The Delta-Mendota Canal serves CVP contractors along the West Side in parts of Merced, Fresno, Kings and Madera counties, including the huge Westlands Water District and the San Joaquin River "exchange contractors." The California Aqueduct

transports State Water Project supplies to farm users in Kings and Kern counties and is jointly used as far south as Kettleman City to help make CVP deliveries.

Surface water supplies tend to vary radically but the Valley is also blessed with outstanding reserves of groundwater. Pumping from the aquifer sustains crops in places and at times that surface water is not available. Many agencies actively seek to use floodwater when it is available to recharge the aquifer. Unfortunately, more groundwater is being used on average than is being replenished.

Nearly every city, village, home, business and industry on the valley floor relies on groundwater, but treated surface water is beneficially used in Coalinga, Huron, Avenal, Friant, Brighton Crest, Orange Cove, Lindsay, Strathmore and Terra Bella. The cities of Fresno and Clovis are currently developing surface water treatment plants. Most domestic water in the mountains is supplied from wells.

Education and Conservation

These go hand in hand. The Central Valley Water Awareness Committee is dedicated to increasing awareness and understanding of water's importance and why it is so critical to wisely use and conserve a resource that, while precious, is much too often in short supply. As shown in the figure on the next page, less than one percent of the world's water is available for use in the form of groundwater or surface water. Conserving water needs to be everybody's job!

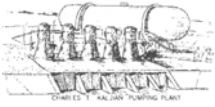
